## **SHOW TERMS & CONDITIONS**

**APPROVALS** – The Event is sanctioned by NRCHA. Classes will be run in accordance with the aforementioned rule book.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Class eligibility will be based on NRCHA recorded lifetime earnings and the NRCHA rulebook.

**MEMBERSHIPS:** Both owner and rider(s) must be current members of NRCHA and NSHA. Memberships can be purchased at the show.

**HORSE REGISTRATION:** It would be nice if you sent a copy of Horse's Breed registration papers. At least make sure the name of the horse you enter on the form is its registered name.

## **FUTURITY / DERBY (LIMITED AGE EVENT) ENTRY INFORMATION:**

1. ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be received by August 3<sup>rd</sup>. No payments are necessary prior to the show. A 25% late fee will be charged for horses entering after the deadline  
DRAWS: Draws will be posted at the NSHA website, [www.nationalstockhorse.com](http://www.nationalstockhorse.com), on August 16<sup>th</sup>.
2. SCRATCHES/CANCELLATIONS:
  - a. Before ENTRY deadline → Full refund with written entry cancellation to the show secretary.
  - b. After deadline, BEFORE DRAW → \$500 scratch fee will be billed. All other monies refunded.
  - c. AFTER the draw → NRCHA fee and Video fee only refunded.
3. SUBSTITUTIONS: Substitutions will be allowed per NRCHA rules. A new entry form and proper paperwork will be required.
4. OPEN ENTRIES & PAYOUTS
  - a. Open entries are automatically entered into all Open divisions for which they are eligible (Intermediate Open, Limited Open only). Open Entry Fees and Added Money will be split across all 3 divisions. 75% of entry fee goes to payout.
  - b. Level One Open may be entered as a stand-alone class or with cross entry into the Open. Level One Payouts are a stand-alone entry fee. 70% of entry fee goes to payout.
5. NON PRO ENTRIES & PAYOUTS
  - a. Non Pro Entries are automatically entered into all Non Pro divisions for which they are eligible (Intermediate Non Pro and Limited Non Pro only).
  - b. Non Pro Entry Fees and Added Monies will be distributed across the divisions: 65% Non Pro, 25% Int. Non Pro, 10% Ltd. Non Pro. 70% of entry fee goes to payout.
  - c. Level 1 Non Pro (formerly the \$7,500 Amateur) does NOT need to enter the Non Pro Division. It may be entered as either a stand-alone class or with cross entry into the Non Pro.
6. NON PRO BOXING
  - a. Futurity is open only to 3-year-olds in a snaffle.
  - b. Derby is open to horses aged 4-5 shown in either hackamore or snaffle or 6-year-olds shown in a snaffle. 6-year-olds may not be shown in a hackamore. Eligibility based on NRCHA Non Pro Boxing LAE eligibility.

## **WORLD'S RICHEST AND SPECTACULAR ENTRY INFORMATION:**

1. ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be received by August 3<sup>rd</sup>. No deposit is required. A late entry fee of \$200 will be charged for entries received after August 3<sup>rd</sup>. Please DO NOT mail any entries after August 3<sup>rd</sup> as they may not be received in time.
2. DRAWS:
  - a. WORLD'S RICHEST:
    - i. HERD WORK will be done on SUNDAY, August 20<sup>TH</sup> after 10:00 a.m. We will make every attempt to post them on the NSHA website.
    - ii. REIN / COW work draws will be done on WEDNESDAY August 23<sup>rd</sup> after 10 a.m.
  - b. HORSE SHOW SPECTACULARS
    - i. HERD WORK Draws will be done on SUNDAY, August 20<sup>TH</sup> after 10:00 a.m.
    - ii. REIN / COW work draws will be done with the concurrent Horse Show Class draw time (see below).
3. SCRATCHES/CANCELLATIONS:
  - a. Before ENTRY deadline → Full refund with written entry cancellation to the show secretary.
  - b. After deadline, BEFORE DRAW → \$500 scratch fee will be billed. All other monies refunded.
  - c. AFTER the draw → NRCHA fee and Video fee only refunded.
4. CROSS ENTRY
  - a. World's Richest – Intermediate HORSE will be auto entered base on eligibility.

- b. Non Pro Bridle Spectacular – Intermediate Non Pro Bridle will be auto entered base on eligibility.
5. 4 EVENT OPTION
- a. Entries into the World's Richest and Non Pro Bridle Spectacular have the option to add the additional muley roping. The additional Add back and Added monies for those classes will be paid in their respective roping go round only.

**HORSE SHOW (non spectacular) CLASS ENTRY INFORMATION:**

1. ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be received by August 13<sup>th</sup>. No deposit is required. A late entry fee of \$100 will be charged for entries received after August 13<sup>th</sup>. Please DO NOT mail any entries after August 3<sup>rd</sup> as they may not be received in time.
2. DRAWS: Draws will be done after 5 p.m. on the evening before the class takes place. We will make every attempt to post them on the NSHA website.
3. SCRATCHES/CANCELLATIONS:
  - a. Before ENTRY deadline → Full refund with written entry cancellation to the show secretary.
  - b. After deadline, BEFORE DRAW → All monies refunded.
  - c. AFTER the draw → NRCHA fee and Video fee only refunded.

**PAYMENT OF FEES:**

1. An open check or credit card number must be provided at the horse show office at the time of check-in. Any returned checks will be charged a \$50 NSF fee.
2. Credit cards can be used to pay any fees that are due. If you want to use this option please download and complete a Credit Card Authorization Form.

**MOVE IN: Move in begins MONDAY at 8am! Please plan accordingly.** If you have not been to the South Point before, please note that move in from Tuesday on is only available from 8am to 7pm. Move out is available anytime – just ask the security guard to open the door.

**STALLS / HAUL-INS:** Stall reservations are due on August 3<sup>rd</sup> and are \$285.00 each. If you are not renting a stall, there is a \$25.00 / day per horse to haul in.

**BEDDING / MATS:** Ordered Stalls come with four (4) bags of shavings. Pre-ordered bedding or mats must be finalized by August 16 (same day as the draw) so the facility has enough time to prepare. If you want to pre-order, you can add it to the stabling request form. NO CHANGES to pre-bed / mat orders after August 16. Pricing for a set of 2 mats is \$44 (2 mats cover most of the stall) and shavings are \$12.50/bag. No outside shavings are allowed. Orders after August 16 must be done when you arrive through the South Point Arena Feed Store.

**OFFICE HOURS:** Office will be open 10-5 on Monday, August 21<sup>st</sup> and will open (1) hour prior to show starting until completion of the classes for the day.

**PRACTICE PENS:** Sign up at the show.

Herd - \$70

Cow Work - \$60

**OTHER FEES:**

Video Fee      \$50 per horse

The NSHA reserves the right to cancel, transfer or reschedule the show without notice and/or liability. In the event of cancellation all entry fees paid to date will be refunded. Interest earned on the entries is the property of the National Stock Horse Association.

### **RELEASE OF LIABILITY**

Registrant acknowledges that riding and cow horses are inherently dangerous activities that expose the participant to a substantial risk of serious property damage, personal injury or death. In consideration for the right to participate in such activities, or any other activity that the registrant may participate in at the NSHA Snaffle Bit Futurity or NSHA Derby registrant assumes the risk of injury or death of participating in those activities and hereby releases the National Stock Horse Association (NSHA) and its employees, representatives and all other agents associated with the NSHA from liability for any personal injury, property damage, or death that occurs from those activities. Registrant further agrees to release and hold harmless NSHA, its employees, representatives, agents and anyone else working at the event who through negligence or carelessness otherwise might be liable in damages to registrant. This release and waiver of liability shall be binding on Registrant heirs, representatives, dependents, and successors of interest. I agree as a condition of acceptance of entry the National Stock Horse Association may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts or other likeness of me and my horse taken during the course of competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport or the NSHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a produced and they may not be used in such a way to jeopardize non pro/amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrecoverable waive and release rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity or to misappropriation. I have the authority and hereby do, by making this entry, assume responsibility for and bind owner, rider and/or agenda to the terms and conditions of the Release and Waiver of Liability. I warrant that I am of legal age, or am the parent or legal guardian of the participant named above, and that I have read and fully understand the foregoing terms.
