NSHA MIXED SALE AT THE RUN FOR A MILLION

The Run For A Million, the richest event in the history of reining, will offer spectators the chance to buy top Western performance horses with the addition of two sales to its 2021 event, to be held Aug. 18-21 at the South Point Arena and Equestrian Center in Las Vegas.

The National Stock Horse Association (NSHA) Mixed Cow Horse Sale, scheduled Saturday, Aug. 21 after the Gala Select Yearling Sale, will feature everything from high-end bridle horses to 3-year-old futurity prospects. Buyers will have a shot at purchasing horses like Metallic Look (Metallic Cat x Smart Lookin Hi Brow), one of the top 20 Open Bridle horses in the 2020 National Reined Cow Horse Association National Standings.

“We think that this is going to be a huge exposure for the cow horse industry, and what we’re trying to do with the sale is have some of the highest-end horses available, horses you wouldn’t normally get a shot at buying,” said Russell Dilday, president of the NSHA. “We’re trying to get them into the hands of people that will go on with them and want to enjoy our sport with them right away.”

The \$150,000 Invitational Fence Work Challenge will take place Friday evening August 20, high lighting the reined cow horse.

The next morning, on Saturday, Aug. 21, an exclusive set of young horses will walk through the ring in the Gala Select Sale, which will feature elite reining-bred yearlings. The sale will be limited to yearlings out of dams that have won and/or produced at least \$50,000.

“Our idea is that Friday evening, you’ll be able to watch the highest end of our horses compete,” Dilday said. “You can have a good time at the South Point, then get up the next morning, watch a high-end reining horse futurity sale and the NSHA Mixed sale to follow, and then that night, watch The Run For A Million. It should be a phenomenal weekend.”
